





About the Vine Trails – Oak Knoll Section of the project:

FROM CALIFORNIA DRIVE IN THE TOWN OF YOUNTVILLE TO
REDWOOD ROAD IN THE CITY OF NAPA IN NAPA COUNTY

Project Scope of Work:

The project is aligned through three municipalities, the Town of Yountville, County of Napa & City of Napa. Each entity has authority over the project and the Public Works Dept. of each has worked closely with NCTPA on the design on the project and will be a partner in completing the work. The project is also within City of Napa Water Dept. and County Flood Control District easements.

- Federal Aid project to construct of a Class I bicycle and pedestrian path following the current alignment of Solano Avenue in the County of Napa from Redwood Road in the south to California Drive in the north.
- Mixed-use facility consists primarily of a 10' wide paved path with 2' shoulders that is completely separate from vehicular traffic along Solano Avenue.
- Majority of the path runs between the Napa Valley Wine Train right-of-way and the existing flood control channels along the project corridor.

The Project will require:

- Construction of (2) bridges over Hinman Creek Collector,
- Modification of the Solano Ave Dry Creek bridge, and
- The widening of the Salvador Channel Wine Country Ave. box culvert;
- Installation of 2 new traffic signals within Caltrans ROW and modifications to the existing Trower Ave. signal,
- Re-alignment of a portion of Solano Ave. in Yountville; tree removal;
- Irrigation and landscaping. (the length of the new trail)
- Existing drainage features and patterns will remain along the extent of the project.
