

WHAT'S BEING PLANNED

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in partnership with the Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency proposes to construct a connector from southbound (SB) State Route (SR) 221 to SB SR 29, and re-align the SB SR 221 connection to SR 29. The purpose of the project is to alleviate congestion and improve traffic operations at the Soscol Junction intersection.
