Mileage Program Provides New Transportation Option for Seniors

NAPA, CA- The Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency (NCTPA) has launched a Mileage Reimbursement program to assist seniors and persons with disabilities living in more rural parts of Napa County to get access to medical appointments and grocery shopping. The program was created by NCTPA to encourage volunteer based transportation for seniors and persons with disabilities who cannot drive and do not have access to public transit. Participants identify a volunteer driver to transport them to qualified medical or grocery trips and NCTPA will reimburse participants for mileage. Applicants must be county residents, live outside public transit service boundaries or be attending a medical appointment outside the service boundaries.
