

RECOMMENDATION

That the Napa Valley Transportation Authority (NVTA) Board (1) select 3 to 5 members to serve on a subcommittee to review ITOC applications and recommend appointments to the ITOC, and (2) appoint the NVTA Chair and Executive Director as two of the members of to serve on the subcommittee.

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

None.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Measure T Countywide Road Maintenance Act and Expenditure Plan (Expenditure Plan) requires that NVTA appoint members of the ITOC to ensure that Measure T revenues are being spent in accordance with the Expenditure Plan. Board action would select 3 to 5 members to serve on a subcommittee to review applications and recommend to the NVTA Board ITOC appointments for consideration at its April 17, 2013 meeting.

Staff recommends that two of the sub-committee members be the Chair of the NVTA Board and the Executive Director of NVTA, both of which are ex-officio non-voting members of the ITOC in accordance with the Expenditure Plan.

PROCEDURAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Staff reports
2. Public comments
3. Motion, Second, Discussion and Vote

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Each ITOC member is entitled to \$250 per quarterly meeting. NVTA would incur costs of \$1,750 per meeting per quarter when meetings are held. It is anticipated that 3 to 4 meetings would need to be held prior to 2018, when Measure T revenues will be made available.

CEQA REQUIREMENTS

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The proposed action is not a project as defined by 14 California Code of Regulations 15378 (State CEQA Guidelines) and therefore CEQA is not applicable.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The Expenditure plan requires that NVTA appoint members to the ITOC. In accordance with the Expenditure Plan and Ordinance, the ITOC will be tasked with:

Review of fiscal and program performance of the retail transaction and use tax transportation program through a biennial performance audit to ensure that all transportation retail transactions and use tax revenues are spent by the Authority in accordance with all provisions of the voter-approved Expenditure Plan and Ordinance

The Expenditure Plan and Ordinance requires an open selection process for the ITOC which will be made up of (7) Committee members who are residents of the County of Napa possessing the following credentials:

- a) One member who is a professional, retired or active, in the field of municipal audit, finance, and/or budgeting with a minimum of five years in a relevant and senior decision-making position in the public or private sector*
- b) One member who is a licensed civil engineer, retired or active, with at least five years of demonstrated experience in the fields of transportation in government and/or private sector*
- c) One member who is a Certified Public Accountant (CPA) and experienced in financial audits*
- d) One member shall be a representative of a Napa region Chamber of Commerce*

- e) *One member from a bona fide taxpayers' association*
- f) *Two members from the public at-large*

These members will constitute the voting members of the ITOC. In addition, the NCTPA/NVTA Chair and Executive Director and the Chair of the NCTPA Technical Advisory Committee (TAC), and the County Auditor-Controller will serve as non-voting ex-officio members of the ITOC.

Dear Interested Applicant:

Napa Valley Transportation Authority (NVTA) is seeking qualified applicants to serve on the Measure T Independent Taxpayer Oversight Committee (ITOC).

NVTA and the Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency (NCTPA) share common Boards and are administered by common staffs. NCTPA is a joint powers authority (JPA) established in June of 1998. The JPA is made of Napa County and the Cities and Town located in Napa. The work activities of NCTPA are defined by the joint powers agreement and overseen by the Board of Directors made up of elected officials from the respective member agencies, and an ex-officio member from the Paratransit Coordinating Council (PCC). NCTPA serves as the countywide transportation planning body for the incorporated and unincorporated areas within Napa County and is responsible for programming State, Federal, and certain local funds for transportation projects within the County. NCTPA is further charged with coordinating short and long term planning and funding within an intermodal policy framework in the areas of highways, streets and roads, transit and paratransit, and bicycle improvements.

NCTPA also operates the Napa VINE transit services, serves as the Abandoned Vehicle Abatement Authority, Green Business Coordinator, regional housing needs allocation (RHNA) Napa sub-regional coordinator, and van pool coordinator (in partnership with Solano County).

The Napa Valley Transportation Authority (NVTA) is the local transportation sales tax authority. On November 6, 2012, the voters in Napa County approved Measure T, the Napa Countywide Road Maintenance Act. Measure T is a ½% sales tax expected to generate roughly \$300 million over a 25 year period beginning July 1, 2018, when the Measure A Flood Tax expires, and is to be used for the rehabilitation of local streets and roads.

In preparation of the Measure T Ballot measure, NCTPA developed an expenditure plan which was approved by NVTA. The expenditure plan can be viewed at <http://www.nctpa.net/measure-t>

The expenditure plan requires that NVTA appoint members to the ITOC. In accordance with the Expenditure Plan and Ordinance, the ITOC will be tasked with:

Review of fiscal and program performance of the retail transaction and use tax transportation program through a biennial performance audit to ensure that all transportation retail transactions and use tax revenues are spent by the Authority in accordance with all provisions of the voter-approved Expenditure Plan and Ordinance

The Expenditure Plan and Ordinance requires an open selection process for the ITOC which will be made up of (7) Committee members who are residents of the County of Napa possessing the following credentials:

- a) *One member who is a professional, retired or active, in the field of municipal audit, finance, and/or budgeting with a minimum of five years in a relevant and senior decision-making position in the public or private sector*

- b) One member who is a licensed civil engineer, retired or active, with at least five years of demonstrated experience in the fields of transportation in government and/or private sector*
- c) One member who is a Certified Public Accountant (CPA) and experience in financial audits*
- d) One member shall be a representative of a Napa region Chamber of Commerce*
- e) One member from a bona fide taxpayers association*
- f) Two members from the public at-large*

These members will constitute the voting members of ITOC. In addition, the NCTPA/NVTA Chair and Executive Director and the Chair of the NCTPA Technical Advisor Committee (TAC), and the County Auditor-Controller will serve as non-voting ex-officio members of the ITOC.

The voting Committee members will serve a two, three, and four year term, determined by the drawing of lots. This is to establish staggered terms to retain institutional knowledge on the Committee. Thereafter, Committee members will serve four-year terms.

The voting Committee members shall receive a stipend of \$250 per quarterly meeting.

The voting Committee members cannot be current local elected officials in Napa County or a full time staff member of any city, town or county government, a local transit operator, or state transportation agency.

ITOC voting members shall have no legal action pending against the Authority and are prohibited from participating in any commercial activity directly or indirectly involving the Authority or NCTPA, such as being a consultant or vendor to the Authority or NCTPA during their ITOC tenure.

ITOC voting members shall not have direct and/or indirect commercial interest or employment with any public or private entity which receives transportation retail transactions and use tax revenues authorized by this Ordinance.

The application deadline is April 1, 2013. It is anticipated that the NVTA Board will appoint the Committee at its April 17, 2013 meeting.
