**Napa CA**, Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency (NCTPA) is seeking public input on the Draft State Route 29 Gateway Plan at two public meetings – Monday, February 10<sup>th</sup> at 6PM at American Canyon City Hall, 4381 Broadway Street, American Canyon and Wednesday, February 12<sup>th</sup> at 6 PM, at NCTPA, Soscol Gateway Transit Center, 625 Burnell Street, Napa.

For the past year, a long-range plan for improvements to Highway 29 between Napa and Vallejo has been discussed by Napa and Solano’s jurisdictions and citizens. Topics considered in the draft plan include upgrades to major Hwy 29 intersections at Jameson Canyon Road/Airport Blvd, at Soscol Road, and Carneros Highway to Sonoma. Significant planning has been done for the segment of Highway 29 that passes through the City of American Canyon. Suggested designs for improving the roadway will be covered for the full length of the highway between the Vallejo Ferry Terminal and the Trancas Park & Ride lot at Redwood Road in Napa.

The draft Plan evaluates a number of issues and potential improvements including:

- Future traffic load
- Intersection configuration
- Bicycle and pedestrian improvements
- Transit improvements
- Costs
- Funding sources

The meeting will present a full overview of the Plan and invite consideration and comments from meeting participants.
