



State Route 29-St. Helena Channelization Project



The Project

Caltrans will do extensive work on northbound and southbound State Route 29 (SR-29) in St. Helena and along SR-29 adjacent to St. Helena in Napa County. The project will rehabilitate the pavement, widen the shoulders, construct a two-way left turn lane, and improve bicycle/highway/railroad crossings at Whitehall Lane.

What to Expect

Motorists may encounter temporary detours, intermittent lanes closures, and see increased heavy construction equipment in the area during the work. Caltrans will provide the public with specific detour locations and times as they become available. Motorists should expect delays. All work is weather permitting.

Detour Routes (when scheduled closures are in effect)


Caltrans will contact the public once detour routes are determined. Please visit our project website for the latest information.
