

NAPA COUNTY PEDESTRIAN MASTER PLAN

Fact Sheet

AS NAPA COUNTY'S FIRST PEDESTRIAN MASTER PLAN, this project is a unique opportunity to have a countywide conversation regarding pedestrian needs and opportunities. The outcome is to establish a policy framework and develop a plan that will enhance pedestrian mobility and safety.

KEY CONSIDERATIONS OF THE PLAN WILL INCLUDE:

- Identifying gaps in the existing pedestrian network.
- Identifying where pedestrian activity occurs.
- How we can better serve key demographic groups, including children, elderly, disabled, and low-income residents, as well as employees and tourists.
- Pedestrian connectivity to transit.
- Improvements that give us the most “bang for our buck.”
- Determining funding sources for these improvements.
- ADA (American Disabilities Act) enhancements.

AT THE CONCLUSION OF THIS PLANNING EFFORT, a collaborative network of technical staff, advocates, and other key stakeholders will be well-positioned to champion the implementation of the plan’s goals, policies, programs, and projects. Each of the five incorporated jurisdictions, as well as the County, will have stand alone Plans, with an integrated vision, but customized approach.
