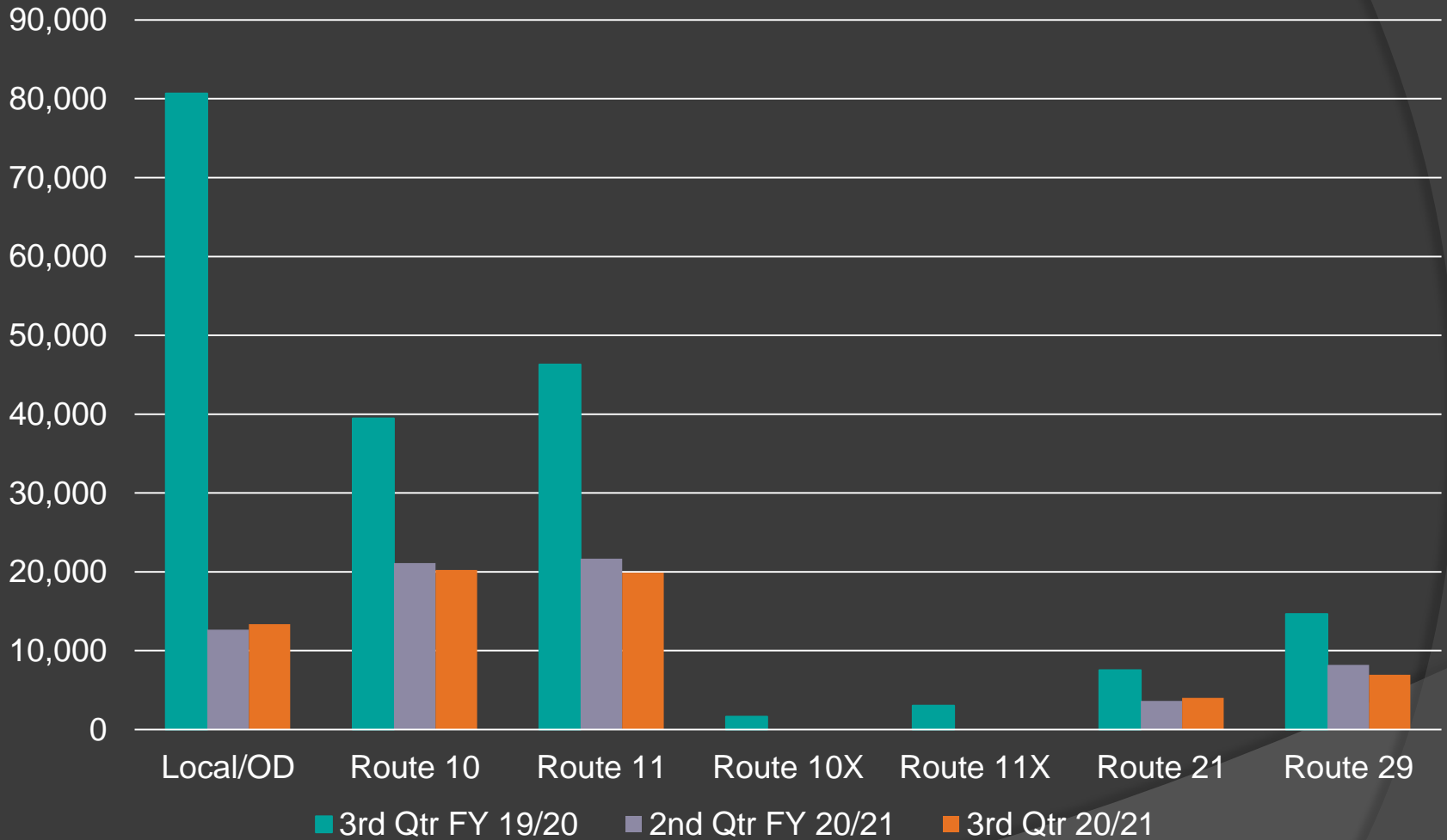
# Emergency Operations Center

- Delivering groceries from the Food Bank to vulnerable families who cannot access the regular distributions because they lack transportation, are disabled or caring for someone who is disabled.

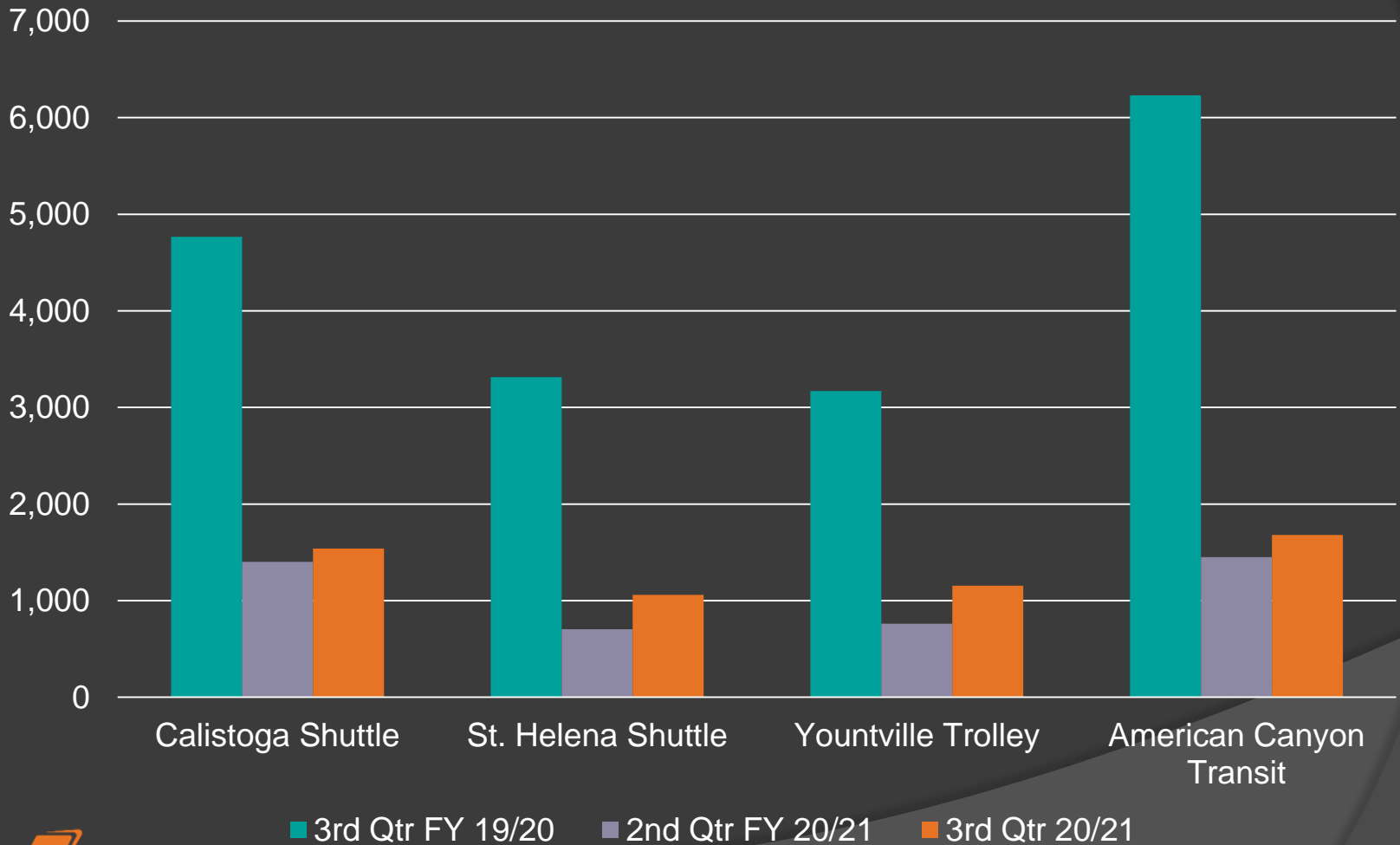

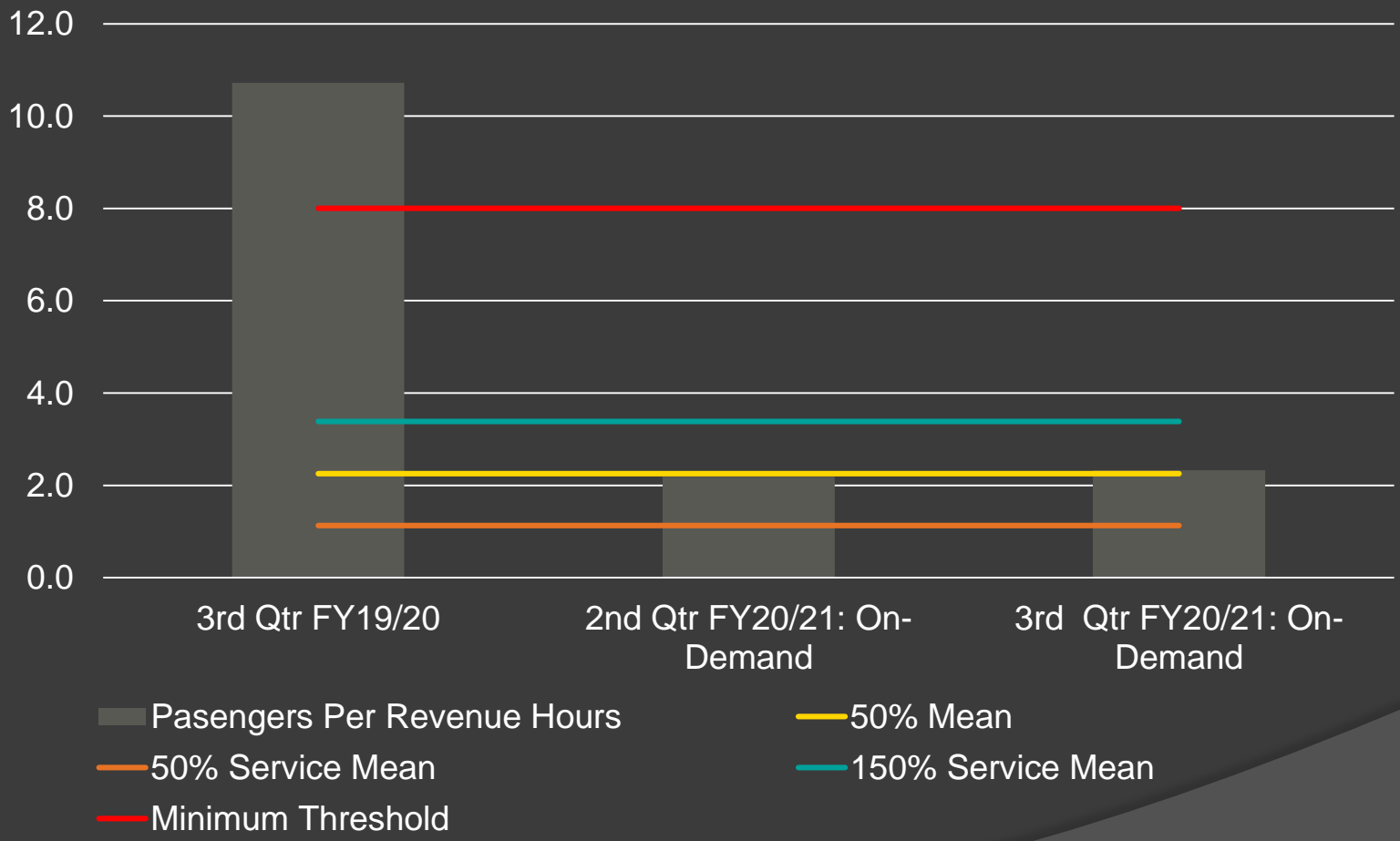
# Total Ridership Change



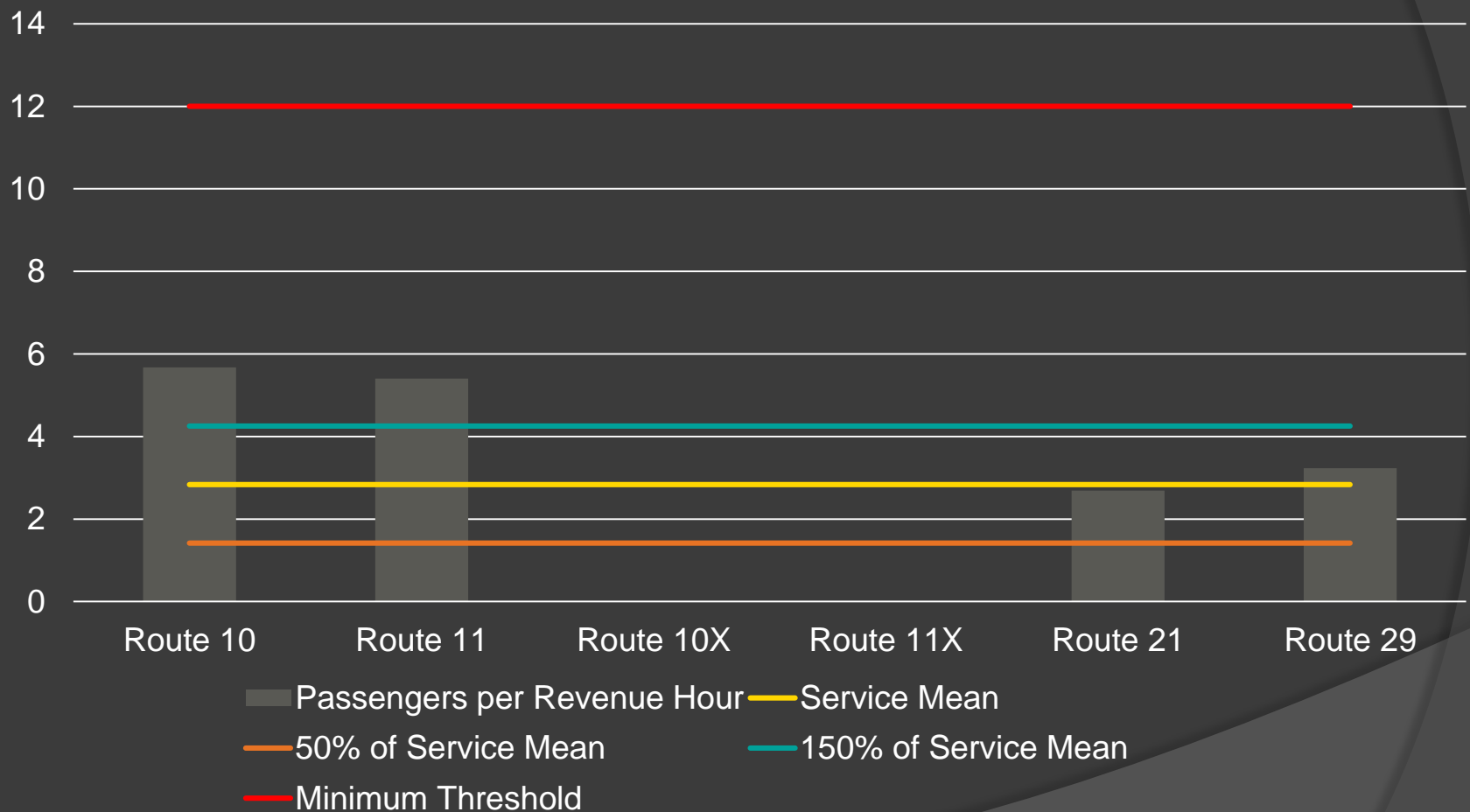
# Total Ridership Change: Shuttles



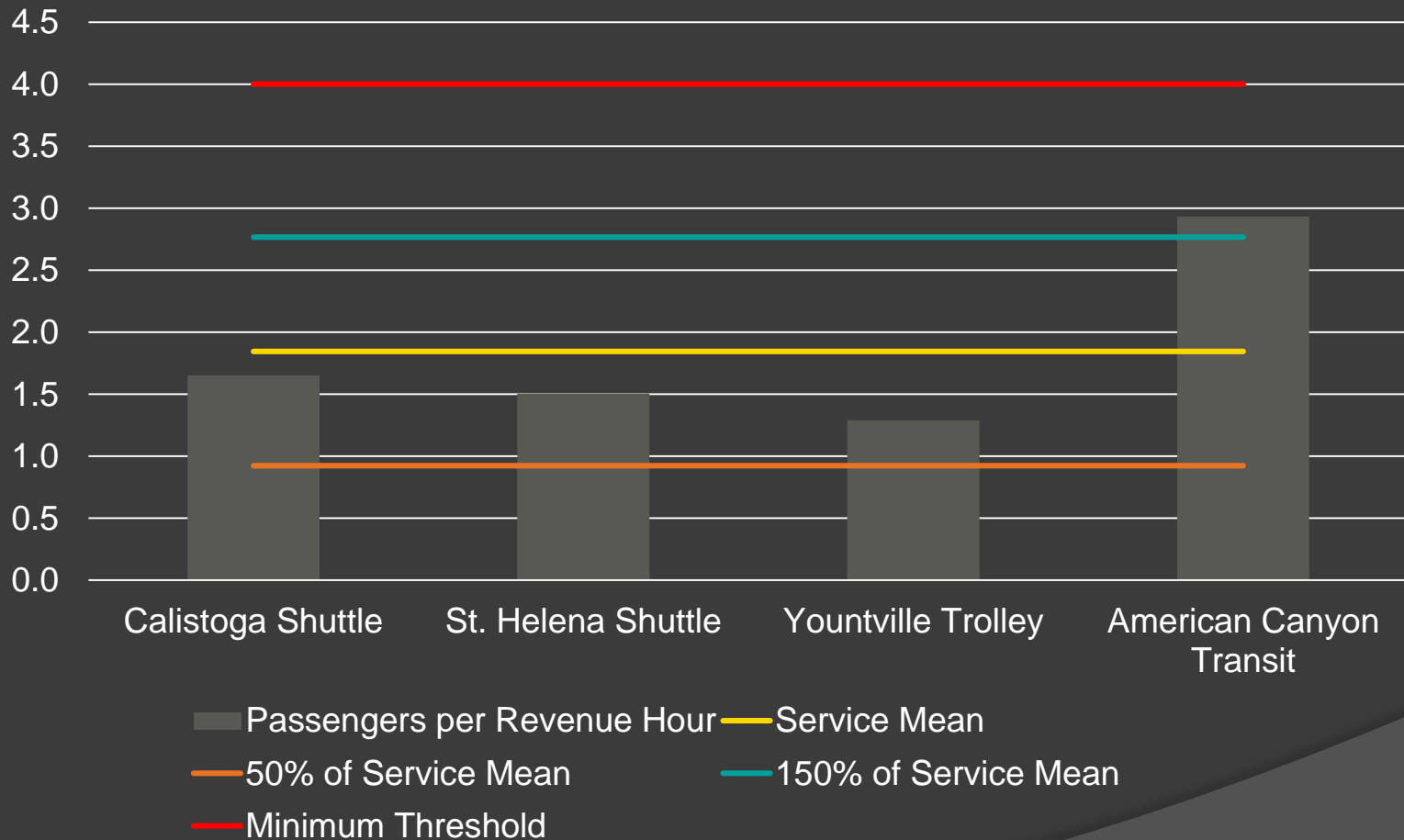
# Local Service Passengers per Revenue Hr (Weekdays)
